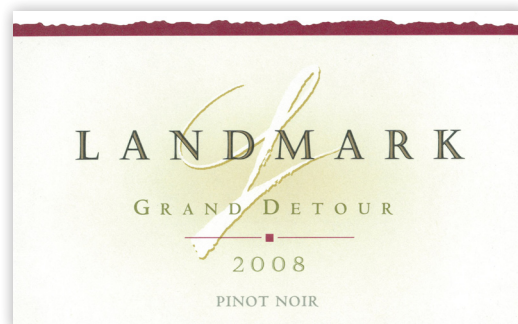

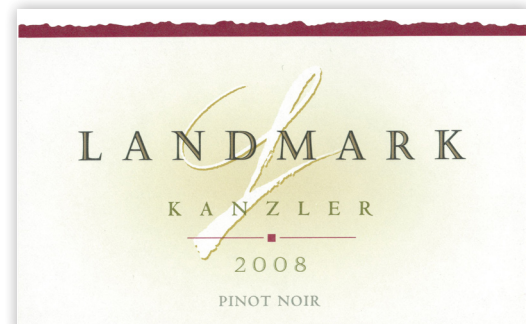

Those who favor this wine will do so for its slightly tighter structure and its seeming willingness to age very well for the next half decade. Its suppleness is given with less ease than its mate (Kanzler), but its balance is impeccable and time is on its side.



☼ ☼ 91

A touch deeper and more obvious than its mate (Grand Detour), and that much more inviting in the short term, this well-focused offering sets black cherry fruit against creamy oak adjuncts in a ripe, lively and fairly rich set of aromas. Full and fairly supple on the palate with firming acidity in the long and inviting finish, it will be liked today and for years to come.
