

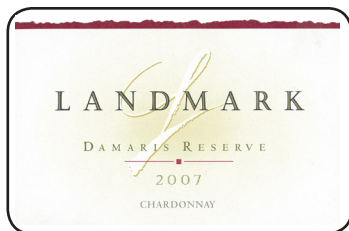


**2008 Overlook Chardonnay (Available in 750 ml & 375 ml)**

*75% Sonoma County, 25% Santa Barbara County*

A blend of twenty-two vineyards carefully selected by Landmark Vineyards and seamlessly integrated by a flavor-driven winemaking style. Aged 10 months in French oak. Has great depth and silky richness balanced by underlying acidity.

**2007 Damaris Reserve Chardonnay**

*89% Carneros, 11% Russian River*

The grapes for this wine comes from two distinctive vineyards Sangaicomano and and Lorenzo. The Carneros fruit contributes an abundance of almond, peach and mango flavors while the Lorenzo Vineyard's crisp minerality and clay soils add accents of pineapple and grapefruit to this complex chardonnay.

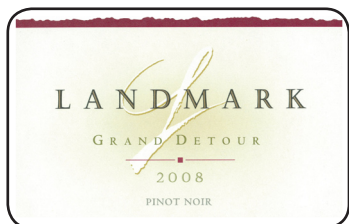


**2007 Lorenzo Chardonnay**

By carefully tasting and blending various lots of Lorenzo barrel by barrel we have achieved the best expression of this unique thirty-year-old vineyard. Has great fruit and fine definition. Full bodied with zesty acidity.

*Sonoma County/Sonoma Coast*

Sourced from the finest Sonoma County and Sonoma Coast Pinot Noir Vineyards. Each component of the blends lends its own silky thread of texture, flavor and aromas.

**90 Points - Robert Parker (2007 Vintage)**

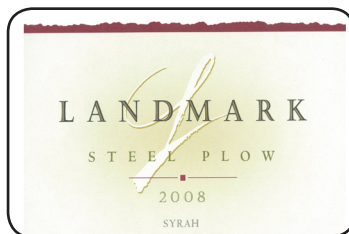


**2008 Kanzler Pinot Noir (Sold Out)**

*Kanzler Vineyard - Sonoma Coast*

This vineyard lies within the Coastal appellation of Sonoma County. Fermentation is carried out by indigenous yeasts in small open-topped fermenters, with hand punchdown. Very dark black cherry color. Notes of dark chocolate, orange peel, smoked black tea and soy sauce.

**2008 Steel Plow Syrah**

*Kivelstadt Vineyard - Sonoma Valley*

Organically farmed, low-yielding vineyard. Ripe plummy fruit and aromas of violets and leather. The supple mouth-feel is balanced by good acid/tannin length.

# LANDMARK VINEYARDS



**M**ichael and Mary Colhoun, the owners of Landmark Vineyards, follow a long family tradition in farming and agriculture. Michael's great-great-great grandfather was John Deere, inventor of the first steel plow and the founder of one of the world's largest farm equipment manufacturing companies.

Landmark's mission is *"to make great wines that enhance the joy of life."* Quality and flavor begin in the vineyards. Landmark sources grapes from a range of different vineyards and those selected are among the finest in the highly diverse microclimates of California's winegrowing regions. Each vineyard has its own distinctive flavors and through blending the wine becomes, as Mary is fond of saying, "greater than the sum of its parts."

While the variation of the wines from vintage to vintage can be dramatic or subtle, the crafting of each year's wine is guided by a single overriding philosophy at Landmark: "less is more." According to Winemaker, Eric Stern, "The less the wine is manipulated, the more flavors and aromas remain for the consumer to enjoy."

The handcrafted aspect of all Landmark wines derives from a centuries-long tradition. At Landmark, through considerable research and experience, we have found that indigenous natural yeast fermentation produces a wine of greater complexity and flavor than the more common commercial yeast practice.

Landmark is best known for award-winning Chardonnays - Overlook, Damaris Reserve, and Lorenzo. However the Pinot Noir program, though relatively new and limited in production, has already achieved premier status. The first Syrah, appropriately named "Steel Plow," was released in 2003.
