"Kastania" Pinot Noir
Sonoma Coast*

The Kastania Vineyard is located in the Sonoma Coast appellation south of the town of Petaluma. It was planted in 1994 and consists of four unique clones of Pinot Noir planted on approximately five acres.

The destemmed and uncrushed grapes were fermented in small macro bins and dairy tanks with hand punch-down three times daily. The clones were fermented and barrel aged separately. The wine was pressed off at dryness and transferred to French oak barrels. After a two week fermentation, the wine was aged for twelve months in a combination of 55% new and 45% one-year-old French oak barrels. The wine was bottled without fining or filtration.
